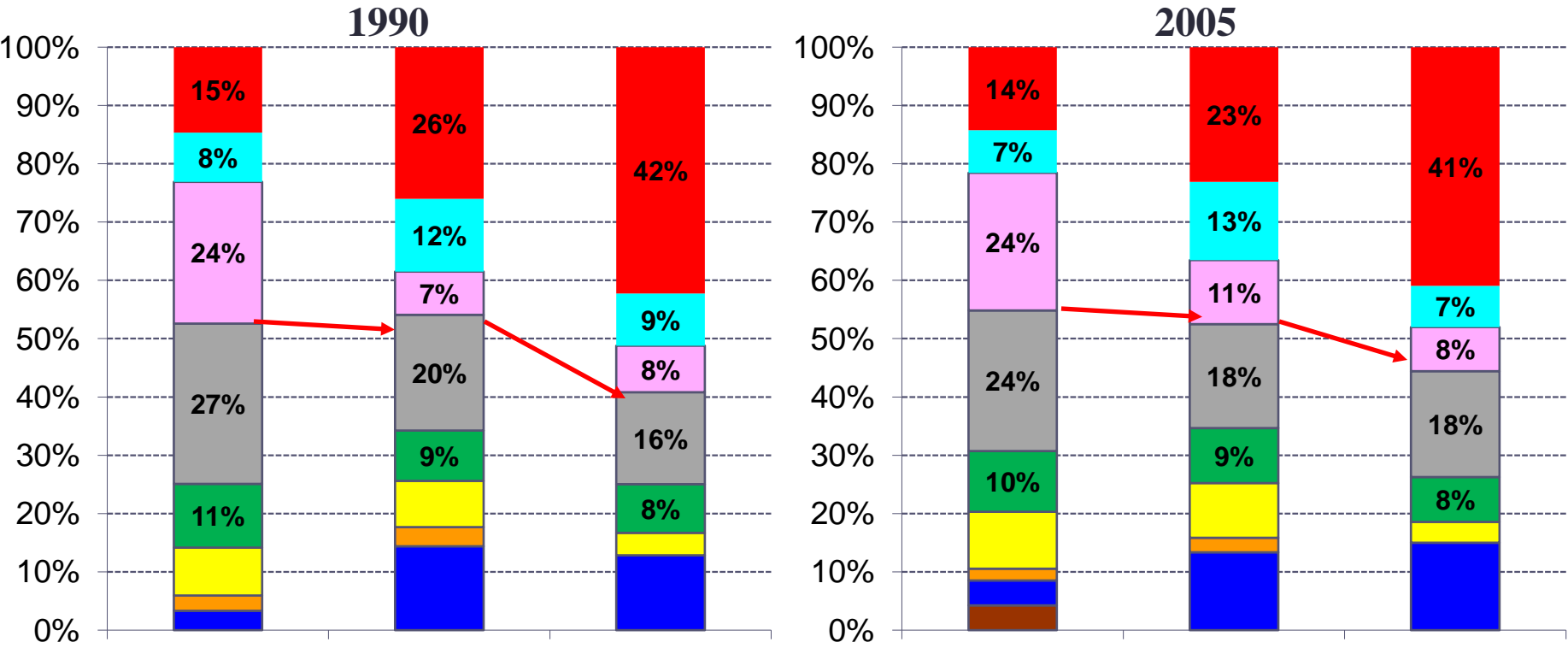


Energy intensive branches (metals minerals and paper) still remain important in the energy consumption of industry: slight increase in the EU (from 46% to 48%) ; slight reduction for USA (from 47 to 45%) and Japan (from 59 to 56%)
